

Students in 8th and 9th grade wanting to take dual credit courses from Ranger College for the 2021-2022 will need to take the TSIA2 exam on Tuesday, April 27th.

All students who want to take Dual Credit courses are required to take the TSIA2 and meet the score criteria prior to being enrolled in dual credit courses.

Dual credit classes are offered online and requires students to be responsible for keeping current on assignments and turning in work in a timely manner. Teacher recommendation is required for English, History, and Math courses as well as the student having an A or high B average in the subject taken.

The following is further explanation about the TSIA2.

The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) was instituted by the Texas Legislature and is a program of diagnostic testing and developmental instruction designed to improve student success rates in Texas colleges. Entering college students are required to meet established minimum standards on assessment tests in math, reading, and writing.

The following TSI scores represent college ready cut scores:

- English Language Arts Reading score of 945 or above and essay score of a 5 or above; or diagnostic score of 5 or above and essay score of a 5 or above
- Mathematics score of 950 or above; or diagnostic score of 6
